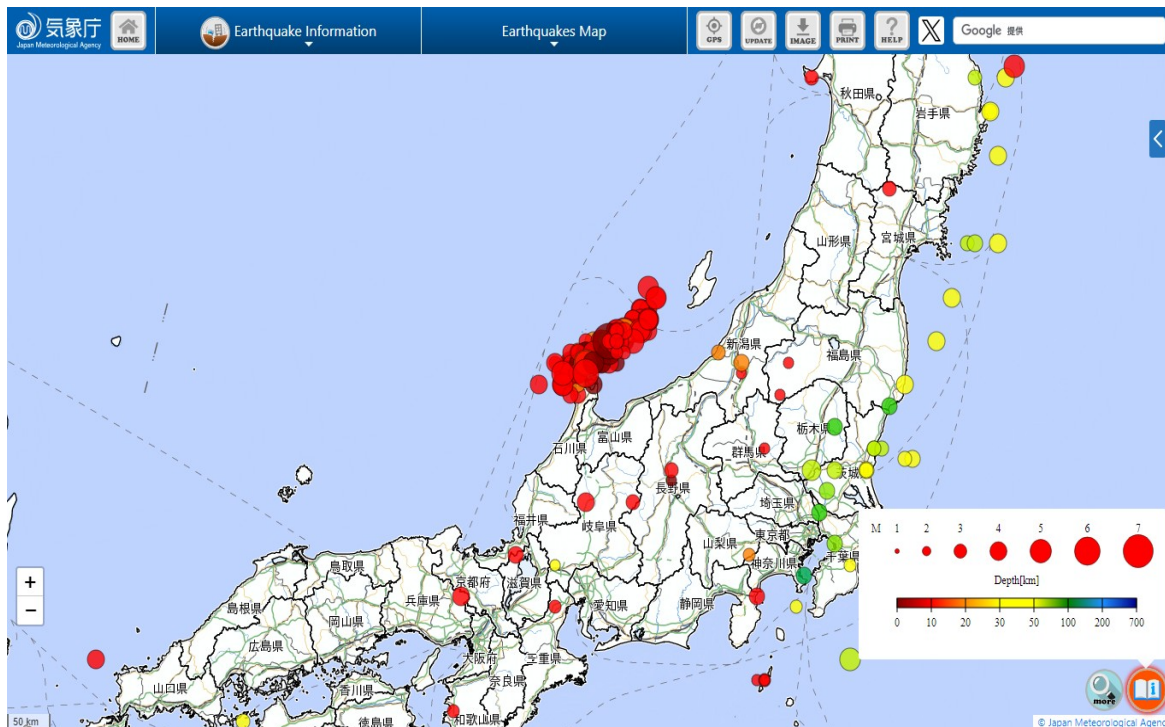


January 2, 2023
